This quick cake with coffee, apple & sultanas is a favourite among residents at Bayview for morning and afternoon tea. The deliciously moist cake is so easy to make - try the recipe at home yourself!



RECIPE

Quick Cake

INGREDIENTS

4 teaspoons coffee
3 cups brown sugar
4 teaspoons cinnamon
1 cup pie apples
2 eggs
4 teaspoons bi carb soda
4 cups hot water
2 cups sultanas
2 teaspoons ground cloves
16oz butter
6 1/2 cups plain flour

METHOD

Dissolve coffee in hot water, combine sugar, dried fruit, apples, spices, butter and coffee mixture in pot, stir over heat until butter melts. Cool, add beaten eggs, flour and bi carb soda. Mix well.

Bake at 180°C for 40-45 minutes.
