Development of the Trevu House Aged Care at Gawler is almost complete, providing 68 residential aged care places in beautifully appointed accommodation.

The multi-million dollar development has provided numerous new jobs for the building trade and health and aged care personnel. It will also provide much needed accommodation and respite for ageing local residents and their families.

Aged Care Services Australia Group's Executive Director of Operations, Jerome Jordan confirmed that the development had provided a large number of temporary jobs in the community.

"The addition of 23 beds will result in much needed residential care

for ageing local residents, at a time when demand for aged care services in this area is on the incline," Mr Jordan explained.

The history of Trevu House

While the new development of Trevu House will provide state of the art facilities and modern technology, it will still retain the heritage features and add thoughtful touches to retain the history and elegance of the historical building.

Built in 1866, far from evoking the windswept Cornish landscape of it's namesake, Trevu - with its position high on the hill, inspires calm with it's tranquil surrounds.

With many heritage listed features such as beautiful ornate ceiling roses and the large original veranda, preserving these elements was of paramount importance.

The 150th birthday of Trevu was celebrated by Trevu House Residential Aged Care residents and staff in September 2010.

The original owner was a man by the name of James Martin, and sometime after his death in 1899 the property was purchased by the Taylor family who ran the Taylor Butter Factory. The property was later purchased by a Mr Thomas Noel Blinman in the late 1950s, He lived on the property and also ran it as a reception house.

In the 1960's the Rotary Club of Gawler met at Trevu, and Blinman changed the business to be a private aged care hospital of 27 beds. 1976 saw the purchase of Trevu by the Brown family who continued to run it as an aged care facility until it was purchased by Whelan Aged Care in 2012. The historic house is now part of Aged Care Services Australia group, (Japara Healthcare) who own and operate 39 facilities across Australia. They have taken over the new development of Trevu, and are committed to offering a state of the art facility while retaining the building's historic charm.

RECIPE

Chocolate Brownies

INGREDIENTS

200g unsalted butter, chopped
200g dark chocolate, broken into pieces
1 cup brown sugar
3 eggs, lightly beaten
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
3/4 cup gluten-free plain flour
2 tablespoons cocoa powder

METHOD

Step 1

Preheat oven to 190°C. Line a 5cm deep, 18cm (base) square cake pan with non-stick baking paper.

Step 2

Heat butter, chocolate and sugar in a saucepan over low heat, stirring constantly, until melted and smooth. Transfer to a heatproof bowl. Set aside to cool slightly.

Step 3

Add eggs and vanilla to chocolate mixture. Mix well. Sift flour and cocoa over chocolate mixture. Stir to combine.

Step 4

Pour brownie mixture into pan. Bake for 20 minutes or until just set. Set aside to cool. Once cooled, lift out. Wrap in plastic wrap. Place into an airtight container. Stand for 1 day. Cut into pieces. Serve.
